REQUIRED APPLICATION MATERIALS

□ Application for Admission

The application for admission should be completed in its entirety to the best of your ability.

Statement of Interest

The statement of interest is an opportunity for you to introduce yourself to the Admissions Committee, and discuss why the MSL program is appropriate for you given your background and goals.

Resume of Curriculum Vitae

The resume included in your Northwestern Pritzker Law application should include professional, education, and leadership experiences you feel are relevant to and exemplify your candidacy.

□ Transcripts

Official transcripts from all post-secondary institutions you have attended should be submitted with your application.

□ Test of English Proficiency

International applicants must submit a valid TOEFL or IELTS score report.

Letter of Recommendation

Letters of recommendation help the Admissions Committee appraise your character, maturity, motivation, and scholarly ability. Only one letter of recommendation is required.

Additional Information

Applicants may choose to submit other optional information including: unofficial standardized test score reports (GMAT, GRE, LSAT, MCAT) and/or additional letters of recommendation.
