**International students** in Northwestern's Graduate Program in Law and Business have a unique opportunity to study both business law and management techniques at two of America's leading graduate schools. Candidates earn a master of laws (LLM) from the Law School and a certificate in business administration from the Kellogg School of Management. The Northwestern experience builds upon students' legal education and work experience in their home countries. Graduates of the program are attuned to the legal and business challenges facing international and U.S. clients.

**The curriculum** of the LLM/Kellogg program consists of upper-level courses at the Law School and several courses of the first-year MBA curriculum at Kellogg. International students in this program are held to the same admission standards as American JD and MBA students and are fully integrated with them. They take the same courses and are graded on the same curve.

## **Build Your International Network**

**Northwestern LLM/Kellogg** students have a global business perspective and valuable first-hand knowledge of other cultures, languages, and political, legal, and economic systems as well as strong networks of international contacts. Work experience is a requirement of admission.

**Our students** represent some of the most talented and diverse foreign-trained lawyers and legal professionals from various countries in Asia, Europe, and Latin America. They hold a JD equivalent from their home countries and have an average of more than four year's work experience in prestigious law firms, corporations, and government offices.

**Graduates** of the LLM/Kellogg program hold F-1 visas, allowing them to work in the United States for 12 months upon graduation. For longer periods of employment, employers may petition for an H-1 visa through Immigration and Naturalization Services.
