Fried Frank and Proskauer Rose Show Financial Growth

Fried, Frank, Harris, Shriver & Jacobson and Proskauer Rose have released financial results for 2005.

Fried Frank's gross revenue rose 8.6 percent to \$390 million, and average equity partner profits rose 8 percent to \$1.24 million.

The firm, which is based in New York, is No. 59 on the 2004 Am Law 100.

Fried Frank represents BellSouth on the company's \$67 billion acquisition by AT&T Inc. of San Antonio, Texas. It's the fifth major M&A deal since April 1999 for which New York-based Fried Frank was hired as BellSouth's lead legal adviser.

Fried Frank has 438 attorneys in five offices in New York, Washington, D.C., Frankfurt, Paris and London.

It was reported that Proskauer Rose recorded a 15 percent increase in fee income, up to \$454 million, as well as a 7 percent rise in partner profits to \$1.22 million.

The New York-based firm is No. 51 on the 2004 Am Law 100.

Proskauer Rose has more than 700 attorneys in eight offices in New York, Los Angeles, Washington, D.C., Boston, New Orleans, Boca Raton, Fla., and Paris. This past summer the firm added to its Paris office six partners and 11 associates from France's Rambaud Martel.
