U.S. District Judge Harold Baer, Jr. seeks a recent law school graduate to assist in the research and writing of a book on criminal sentencing policy. The book will include a short history of criminal sentencing policy in the United States, a discussion of recent judicial and legislative developments, and an empirical study of individuals who have been sentenced in the Southern District of New York with the goal of disseminating information on how sentencing might reflect the likelihood of recidivism. The position will entail working directly with Judge Baer in the research, writing, and editing of the book. Candidates should demonstrate strong research and writing skills and an interest in criminal justice and public policy; a background in social sciences is a plus. The position is unpaid. The title of the position is flexible and potential co-author credit is negotiable.
