As an employer who participated in our Fall 2007 On-Campus Interviewing Program, you have access to the NLaw Student Search through Symplicity (<https://law-northwestern-csm.symplicity.com/>). Access to 2L, 3L, and LLM resumes begins on October 1, with first year law student resumes available beginning December 1. NLaw Student Search closes on May 1 each year.
