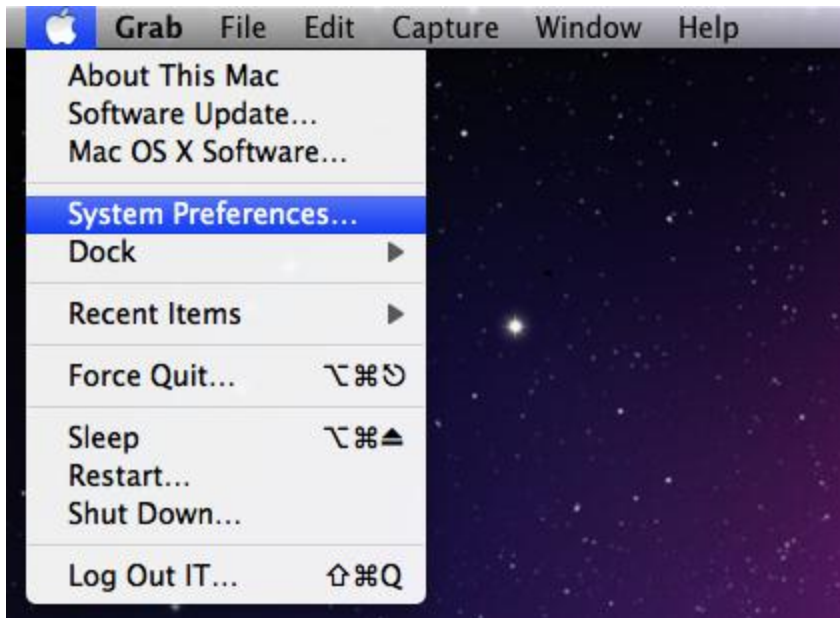


VPN Configuration for Mac OS X

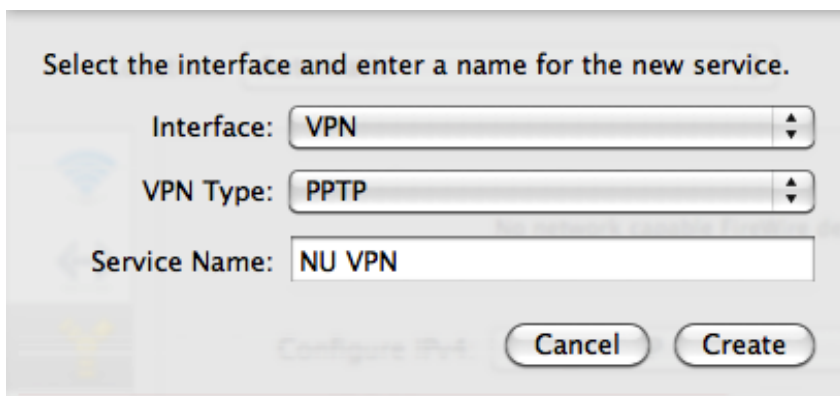
VPN Services are used off-campus when you need to connect to on-campus resources.



Click on the **Apple Menu** (top-left corner of screen), and select **System Preferences**.

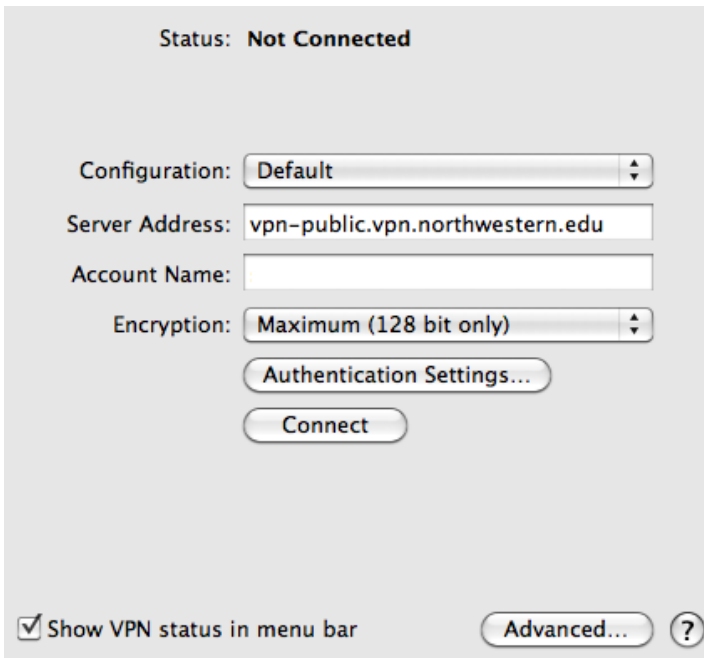


Under **Internet & Wireless**, select **Network**.

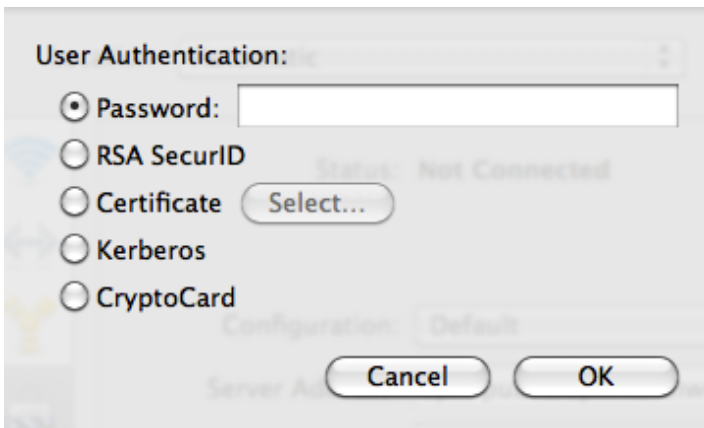


At the lower-right corner of the screen, click the "+" symbol to add a connection, and fill out the fields as shown in the picture.

When finished, click **Create**.



Next, fill out the VPN properties screen as shown, entering **your netID** for account name.



After that, click on **Authentication Settings**, and select **Password** for the authentication type.



You are now ready to connect. Click on the VPN Toolbar icon (circled), and select **Connect**. When prompted, enter your **netID** and **password**.

If you see a timer appear next to the icon after typing in your login information, you are connected. To disconnect, click on the icon, and select **Disconnect**.
