PUBLIC DEFENDER FOR HONOR CODE VIOLATIONS

Sec. 101. The Board shall appoint a Law School student to serve as the permanent defender for that school year of those accused of honor code violations.

Sec. 102. The appointment shall be made pursuant to procedures established by the Board.

Sec. 201. The defender shall be empowered to receive the complaint from the prosecutor and to transmit it to the accused. He shall be further empowered to advise the accused of the procedures which the Board will follow as well as his rights and duties under the honor code.

Sec. 202. The defender shall offer to assist the accused in the preparation of his defense and to appear on his behalf at the hearing; however, the accused shall retain the right to reject the aforesaid offer and to secure counsel of his own choice pursuant to Article III, Section 3 of the honor code.
