Graduate Selection Process

The selection process is competitive, and limited to graduates of Northwestern University School of Law.

Employer Selection Process

Applicants identify as a host organization (a) a domestic non-profit 501(c)(3) agency that provides legal services for underrepresented communities or issues; or (b) a local, state or federal government agency. The host organization must agree to employ the applicant as an attorney for one year.

2. Transition to Practice Program
