Delivering 100% Carbon-Free Energy: Options & Issues

The Biden administration has made addressing climate change one of its top priorities, including moving the nation towards net-zero carbon emissions by 2050. The power sector, which has reduced its emissions 33 percent below 2005 levels as of 2019, can play a key role in achieving this goal. Cities, states, and large corporations—many of which have taken important initial steps to reduce carbon emissions—can also play a key role in reaching this goal by working with electric companies to use 100% carbon-free energy across their operations. Key steps to realizing the 100% carbon-free energy opportunity are: using a broad portfolio of zero carbon resources including hydro, nuclear, storage, and carbon capture and storage (CCS) in addition to renewable energy; taking advantage of demand-side resources such as energy efficiency and demand response; electrifying a greater portion of total energy use by electrifying fleets; and moving from purchasing goals to energy use goals.
